Please consider the following when making your nomination. Nominee should have:

1. Communicated subject matter effectively so that all in attendance could have received a basic understanding of course content.
2. Demonstrated a comprehensive knowledge of subject matter as state in college catalog and course syllabus.
3. Communicated enthusiastic interest in his or her field. This must have been evident to the student.
4. Stimulated the student's thinking, challenged the student's intellect, and developed the student's understanding. It is expected that any University course, properly taught, would transcend an experience in memorization.
5. Shown a personal interest in the student, and been willing to help "above and beyond" the classroom.
6. Been supportive of the mission of the University, fellow faculty members, and any University student.

Nominator should submit with the nomination form: (a) Letter of Testimonial in recommendation of the nominee; and (b) former classmates or former student's letters in support of the nominee.

PURPOSE

Traditionally, the University of Rio Grande has sought to offer its students the highest quality academic instruction. The Educators' Hall of Fame exists so that the finest of Rio Grande's former instructors may be recognized for their

- 1.) Knowledge of subject matter and ability to communicate subject matter with their students
- 2.) Positive influence upon students
- 3.) Positive contributions to Rio Grande's academic environment and workplace

It is the purpose of the Educators' Hall of Fame Committee to select those individuals qualified for induction from among the nominees.

NOMINATION

Any alumnus may nominate a former University of Rio Grande faculty member. Nominations for inductees will not be based upon the number of forms submitted or being held on an individual, but upon the quality and contributions of that individual.

The deadline for nominations is February 1. Forms received after that date will be considered the next year. The nominee must receive the approval of 60% of the selection committee members in order to secure his/her induction.

In the year of its establishment, 1993, the Hall recognized five (5) inductees. Thereafter, the number of inductees was limited to two (2) per year. (Exceptions can be made as deemed appropriate by, and supported by, the selection committee.) The committee may elect to not select any one in a particular year.

Nomination forms for the Educators' Hall of Fame are available through the Office of Alumni Relations.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee will meet annually to determine the individual(s) to be inducted into the Educators' Hall of Fame. The meeting will be called by the Director of Alumni Relations, and members notified of such. Committee members must be present at this meeting in order to vote.

Committee shall consist of:

- Chairman, Educators' Hall of Fame Committee
- Director of Alumni Relations
- President, Alumni Council
- Vice President for Academic Affairs
- Current Educators' Hall of Fame member

INDUCTION

The induction ceremony will be held as part of an Alumni Event, to be determined by the Alumni Director. Inductees will receive a token of recognition display from the Alumni Association, and their name will be put on a plaque, which is on permanent display in the lobby of the Student Center.
